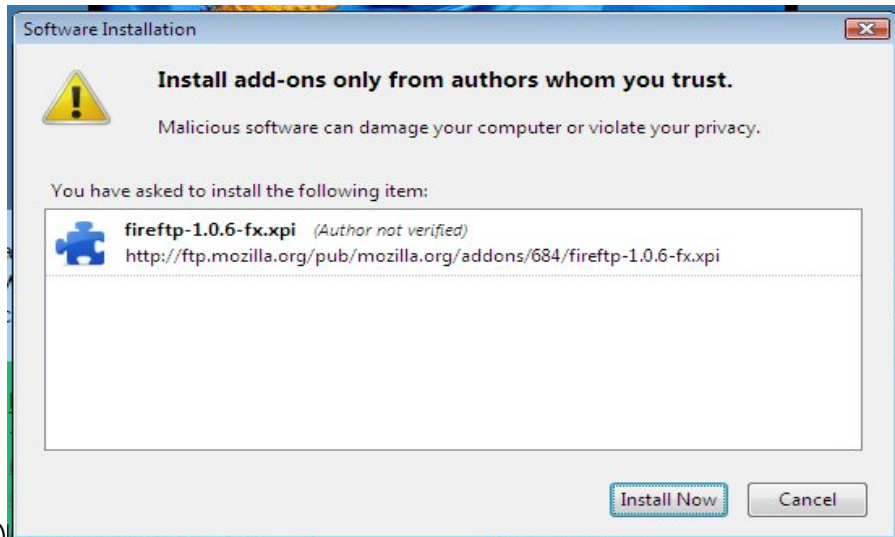
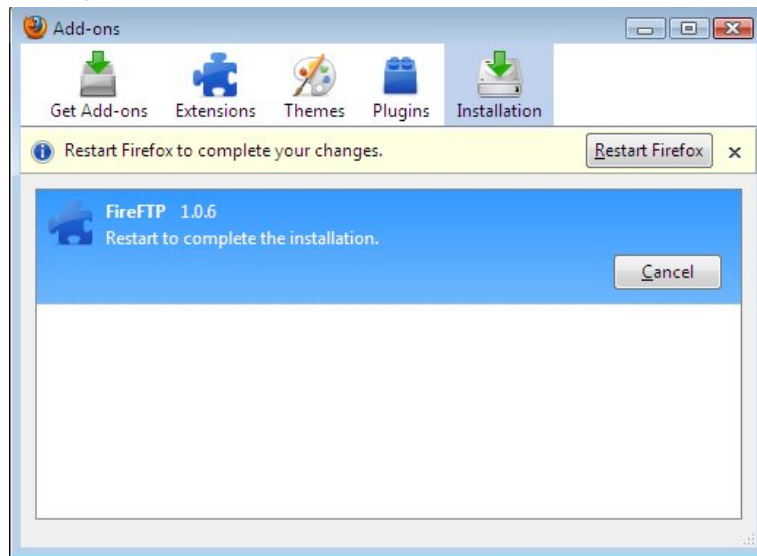


How to Configure FTP for FireFox

- 1) Download and Install FireFTP
 - a) Go to <http://fireftp.mozdev.org/>
 - b) Click "Download FireFTP" (you may to click "Allow" in upper right-hand corner)
 - c) Click "Install Now" and then "Restart FireFox" (See:



Below)



- 2) Configure FireFTP
 - a) In Firefox click Tools from the top menu and choose "FireFTP"
 - b) Click "Create an Account" from the drop down menu in the upper-left hand corner
 - c) In the Account Manager dialog box enter the following IP Address in the "Host" space:
75.77.33.250
 - d) Check the box Labeled "Anonymous"
 - e) Click the "Connection" Tab at the top of the Account Manager Dialog Box.

- f) Uncheck the box for "Passive Mode" so it is disabled.
 - g) Click OK to close the Account Manager Dialog Box
- 3) Configure FireFox to automatically use FireFTP for all FTP links
- a) Click the "Tools" drop-down menu from within FireFTP (On the right between Log/Queue and Help) and Choose "Options"
 - b) Click the Interface Tab in the Options Dialog Box
 - c) Check the option to "Configure FTP links in Firefox to automatically use FireFTP" and make sure the sub option to "Use Passive Mode for these connections" is Unchecked/disabled"
 - d) Click OK to close the Options Dialog Box
- 4) Go to <http://www.bergeronlanddev.com/> and click on the Engineering Plans FTP link
